

THE PHILOSOPHY OF THE SCHOOL

Philosophy is search for truth and wisdom and the science of all sciences. The dominant philosophy that guides the nursing knowledge is humanism that defines about the nature of human beings and the human environment relationship, it emphasizes on humanistic or moral values of caring and the promotion of individual welfare and rights. It is also an art of reasons that explore values. The philosophy of a nursing school defines the value statements about both the practice and the teaching of Nursing. The statement reflects the values, beliefs goals or opinions as agreed upon by the members of the school faculty. The philosophy of education gives direction to the aim of education. Important philosophies of education are idealism, naturalism and pragmatism.

The philosophy of nursing education determines the aims, objectives, content, method of teaching and evaluation. It deals with beliefs and values with regard of man as a learner, educator and nurse or patient, In addition it also deals with beliefs about society, nursing health etc. We believe that the basic course in nursing should prepare nurses for first level positions in nursing both in the definition of ICN of the unique function of the nurse which is to assist the individual sick or well, in the performance of those activities contributing to health or to its recovery (or to peaceful death) that he would perform unaided if he had the necessary strength, will or knowledge and to do this is such a way as to help him gain independence as rapidly as possible.

Keeping the above concept in mind, the curriculum is planned so to provide for experience in all major clinical areas of nursing in the hospital and in the community area. The curriculum should develop in the student an ability to meet the patients' mental and emotional needs and an awareness of the social nature of man, which will enable her/him to see the patient as a person with a family and a member of the community.

It should emphasize preventive, promotive and rehabilitative aspects of heath throughout and the hospital, community, school environment and facilities provided should make it possible to put these principles into practice

AIMS

- To build upon the skills and competencies acquired at the diploma in nursing level.
- To provide an educational programme through which the graduates will be prepared to assume responsibility in the primary, secondary and tertiary care of the people as professional nurses.
- To upgrade the critical thinking skills competencies and standard required for the practice of professional nursing and midwifery.
- To develop excellence in nursing with a view to generate new innovative approaches in health care system.
- To assume the role of teachers, supervisors and managers in clinical and public health settings
- To facilitate in conducting research studies in the area of nursing practice.

OBJECTIVES

On the completion of General Nursing & midwifery diploma programme they will be able to:-

- 1. Demonstrate competency in nursing skill.
- 2. Participate as members of health team in the preventive, curative and restorative health care delivery system of the country.
- 3. Assess health status and identify nursing needs, plan and implement and evaluate nursing care for patients that contribute to health of individuals, families and communities.
- 4. Demonstrate leadership qualities and decision making abilities in various situations.
- 5. Participate in research activities and utilize research findings in improving nursing standards.

- 6. Recognize the need for continued learning for their personal and professional development.
- 7. Practice ethical values in their professional and personal life.
- 8. Demonstrate skills in teaching, management, interpersonal relations and communication.

COURSE OF STUDY

- General Nursing & Midwifery
- Number of Intake :60 (Sixty) per year

SELECTION & ADMISSION

- The admission committee shall do the selection procedure; i.e. Scrutiny of application, conduct the written test and interview.
- 2. The selected candidates after the interview will have medical check-up at this hospital on their own expenses.
- 3. Medically fit candidate will have to pay the non-refundable Admission Fee in advance to reserve the seat.
- 4. Any candidate with criminal record will not be eligible for admission.

NOTE

The students have to pay the fees and other dues for the entire Academic Session if she leaves the School in the middle of the Session. No Certificate, transfer/ migration certificate will be issued unless the entire amount of the prescribed fees is paid.

COURSE OF STUDY & DURATION OF COURSE

- The Diploma course in General Nursing and Midwifery shall be of three years duration.
- There should be a preliminary period of 12 weeks. During this time the student will attend the wards for observation, and supervised practice not exceeding 16 hours per week.

VACATION

Annual Leave - 30 days Study Leave - 2 weeks

- 1. All the institutional holidays will be observed by the school.
- 2. In case of illness, students may avail 10 days sick leave per year. Sick Leave shall be prescribed by the Doctor of M.G.M. Medical College & Hospital, Kishanganj
- 3. Vacation is planned according to the programme of study in each year.

ADMISSION (TERMS AND CONDITIONS)

- 1. Minimum education eligibility criteria for admission to GNM:
- a. 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks at the qualifying examination and English individually from any recognized board. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government. However Science is preferable.
- b. 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational ANM course from the school recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
- c. 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational Stream-Health care Science from a recognized CBSE board/state/Centre
- d. Registered ANM with pass mark.

FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS

The entry qualification equivalent i.e. 12th standard will be obtained by

- Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi Institution,
- State Nursing Council will be responsible to ensure that the qualification and eligibility will be equivalent to what has been prescribed as above.

2. RESERVATION

a) For disabled candidates: 3% Disability reservation to be considered with a disability of locomotors to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity and other eligibility criteria with regard to age and qualification will be same as prescribed for each nursing programme.

NOTE:

A committee to be formed consisting of medical officer authorized by medical board of state government and a nursing expert in the panel which may decide whether the candidates have the disability of locomotors of 40% to 50%.

- b) 5% of total marks is relaxed for SC/ST candidates.
- c) Any other reservation as per the State Govt.

NOTE:

Reservation shall be applicable within the sanctioned number of the seats.

- 1. Admission of students shall be once in a year.
- 2. Students shall be medically fit.
- 3. Minimum age for admission will be 17 years (as on 31st December of that year). The upper age limit is 35 years.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The students will have to abide by the rules & regulations of the hostel & the institution, subjected to revision from time to time.
- She must observe all the rules and discipline of the hostel, school and also in hospital.
- 3. They shall undergo practical training in M.G.M. Medical College & L.S.K. Hospital.
- 4. During the practical training she must accept all types of nursing duties in any shifts, as assigned to her.
- 5. Any students falling sick during training must go for a medical checkup in the concerned department.
- 6. Any illness and medical checkup must be informed in Principal's office.
- 7. In case any student falling sick being at home, must bring the guardian's letter and also a medical certificate.
- 8. Students shall do nothing inside or outside the hostel, school or hospital that will interfere with its orderly administration and discipline.
- 9. Students shall be expected to take proper care of the School Hostel & Hospital property and to help in keeping the premises neat and tidy. For damaging or disfiguring walls, doors, furniture etc the student will be liable for punishment as breach of discipline.
- They shall not leave behind their books or any valuable belongings in the classroom or laboratory after class/study.
- 11. In case of serious breach of discipline or misconduct, the student shall be liable for suspension / dismissal.
- 12. Any student involved in ragging of any sort shall be liable for appropriate action.
- 13. Students have to wear simple dress, suitable for an academic environment.
- 14. They have to handle the library books properly and return it on time without any damage such as tearing, cutting, making dirty etc.
- 15. Silence must be maintained in the Study Hall and Library.
- 16. They are expected to develop keep interest in the extra-curricular activities by taking participation in the competitions, sport, games etc. on the various occasions.
